## Code of Conduct

### Children and Young people

**As a child or young person taking part in the club or activity, we'd like you to follow this guidance to ensure you can play bowls and play safely**

#### **The essentials:**

- ✓ Keep yourself by actively listening to your coach, behaving responsibly and speak out when something isn't right
- ✓ Respect and take care of the clubs equipment and facilities
- ✓ Show good time commitment when arriving to training or matches and communicate to the appropriate member of staff or coach if you will be late
- ✓ Ensure that you are professional and presentable by wearing or bringing the correct kit to training and matches

#### **Behaviour**

- ❖ Be a champion for everyone to feel included and celebrate differences across the club
- ❖ Report any incidents of bullying even if you're just a witness
- ❖ Treat others with respect and appreciate that everyone has different levels of skills and talent – including other young people, staff, coaches from the club and other clubs
- ❖ Be a champion for everyone to feel included and celebrate differences across the club
- ❖ Encourage a friendly and welcoming environment throughout the club
- ❖ Encourage good sportsmanship, positive behaviour and commitment to the sport across the club
- ❖ Follow the clubs online safety and internet use policies

#### **As a child or young person, the club understand you have the right to:**

- Enjoy your time that you spend at the club and feel supported within your role
- Informed of who you can talk to if you have a problem or something is not right
- Feel listened to , included, value, welcomed and not judged
- Have an involvement and contribute to the decision making process within the club
- Access to any relevant and ongoing training in all aspects of your role
- Be looked after if there is an accident or injury and have your parents/carer informed if necessary

There is an expectation that all children and young person are to follow the behaviours and standards set out in the code of conduct. If any child or young person behaves in a way which goes against the expected behaviours, the club will address the problem straight away with the aim to resolve it.

Persistent concerns and repeated acts going against this code may result in you being asked to leave the activity, event or club.
